It is our goal that all children have the opportunity to learn to swim and enjoy the water safely. As such, we look forward to working with your child through the school swimming program to achieve this.

If this is the first time that your child is swimming with us, we would like to extend a warm welcome and hope that your experience here is a fantastic one. For those of you with children returning to our program, we would like to welcome you back and thank you for your continued support.

As a national award-winning program, we are proud to offer a program that caters to the individual needs of each student. We believe in quality over quantity and assess children based on their ability to perform strokes, not the distance or speed that they can swim.

In our experience, children swimming with incorrect technique over long distances can turn bad habits into a permanent part of their stroke. For this reason we prefer to teach basic skills over short distances before adding more advanced skills and distances.

Our AUSTSWIM qualified instructors will work with your child to ensure they feel more comfortable in the water, have improved their overall technique and are able to keep themselves safe in an emergency.

We look forward to having your child participate in our program.

2019 AIS School Swimming - Conditions of Enrolment

Before registering your child, we ask that you read and you accept the following conditions of enrolment:

- Parents are only permitted to attend swimming lessons in the second week of the program.
- All enquiries regarding your child's swimming lessons must be directed to the swimming contact at your school, who will then notify us.
- Our School Swimming lessons are charged at \$69.00 per student for 10 lessons. This is a savings of over 60% off our regular term lessons. Therefore, **no further discounts will be applied and no missed lessons can be made-up or refunded.**
- The above charges do **NOT** include transport to and from the pool which must be arranged by the school externally.
- All children swimming are required to wear the AIS Swim School cap they will receive. If your child comes to lessons without this cap, he/she will receive another one and a charge of \$3.00 will be invoiced to your school. As swim caps are colour coded for each school, we cannot allow children to wear their own personal cap.
- Please keep in mind that students will be active throughout their swimming classes, therefore, attire that is conducive to lessons must be worn. All swimmers should be well fitted and we ask that neither recreational bikinis nor long board shorts are worn as they impede correction and movement through the water.
- The ASC, from time to time, may take photographic, sound and video images of your child or your child's likeness and use them in print, digital and electronic media for the purpose of promoting the AIS and the ASC. Any objection to this must be noted to the swimming contact at your school.
- **Please note that if your child's assessment letter and indemnity form are not received at least two weeks prior to the commencement of lessons, he/she will not be able to participate in lessons.**
