Canteen

Bike and Scooter Use

With the warmer weather approaching, we encourage students and families to take advantage of the bike paths we have in the Molonglo Valley. As a school, we request that if your child wishes to ride to school that they wear a helmet, don't ride inside the school grounds and use known bike paths to and from school. On Tuesdays, lunchtime wheels is offered as a structured play option for students who ride to school. We encourage students to take advantage of this opportunity. All wheels must be stored in the bike shed area at the end of building 6 once students arrive at school. This is locked during the day.



Sun Protection Measures

Next term, students at CWSC will be required to wear hats outside during break periods, outdoor and Physical Education programs. Hats worn must be wide brim, bucket hat or legionnaires style hat. Students who do not have hats will be asked to play in a shaded area. School hats are available for purchase in the front office.

The school is becoming accredited by the Cancer Council as a sunsmart site. As a part of this process, the CWSC Sun Protection policy has been revised to align with Cancer Council recommendations. This includes using the Sunsmart endorsed widget, which measures daily UV levels and will advise when hats are required. Teaching staff will use this tool to reinforce the importance of using sun protection. Our new process will be when the UV hits 3, hats are on regardless of the time of year.
